

Clients: How do I view the clients that are currently connected to my FREESCO router?

Try this method :

Copy the attached file to directory /pkg/bin on your router

Then :

```
[Linux] chmod +x online
```

Then you can use it by typing :

```
[phbc50@Freesco] online
```

```
IP
```

```
10.0.1.2
```

```
10.0.1.4
```

```
[phbc50@Freesco]
```

Notes (by dingetje):

This script requires 'gawk' which may not be available on your FREESCO box.

Another method of listing the masquerade entries of your box (connections made by clients via NAT) is to use the next command:

```
ipfwadm -M -l -n
```

With the `utils_1.1_dingetje` package installed you can also view the established connections to your FREESCO itself (web server, FTP, telnet etc):

```
netstat -a -n
```

(the `-n` option in both commands suppresses DNS name lookup and produces thus much faster output, but of course then you have IP addresses. Without the `-n` you'll get domain names, at the expense of a slower output)
